For those seeking to combine child-centered learning with academic benchmarks, our Wednesday Land Lab program offers opportunities for observation, exploration, and hands-on innovation. Our goals include:

Understanding the natural world through studies in plants, animals, ecosystems, and weather patterns.

Discovering the interconnectedness of living and non-living things and the environment.

Establishing a practice of stewardship in nature through developing personal connections to it.

Mastering basic science concepts (including growth, change, and interdependence) through nature-based challenges.

Developing skills in critical thinking and problem-solving.

Providing artistic challenges using natural materials and the inspiration of environmental themes.

Farm Fridays

We continue our tradition of Farm Fridays, with discoveries and explorations of farm, fields, and forest. Our Fridays are full of heritage handcrafting, community building projects, outdoor investigations, preparation for our end-of-semester Farm Stand, and many opportunities for choice and emerging interests. We encourage nature practices that develop stewardship and creativity alongside camaraderie and good old fashioned play and adventure.

Tuition for each 14-week semester is \$675 for a single day, \$1350 for two days.

We plan to run all programs rain/snow or shine, cancelling only if wind chill temperatures fall below freezing for an extended time or if transportation is hazardous. Our heated hoop house provides a comfortable break from cold, wet weather, and our barn overhang offers shade and fans for hot weather. If a child needs to withdraw for medical reasons, a physician's documented medical reason will enable the child to receive a refund for the portion of the session not attended.
